**SUBJECT:** Teaching, Educating, And Mentoring (T.E.A.M.) School Liaison Program  
November 18-21, 2019, Training

The Michigan State Police, Grants and Community Services Division, Prevention Services and Secure Cities Section, will provide school resource officer training for sworn officers and security officers working with youth. T.E.A.M. training focuses primarily on a proactive effort to make schools and communities safer, and on promoting responsible citizenship, and positive character traits among students in grades K-12. Officers attending this training will receive essential information regarding school violence, bullying, classroom management, public speaking, school and community relations, and safety issues. The curriculum compliments the Michigan Model for Health Curriculum utilized by all schools in the state of Michigan. The class is Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards approved. The T.E.A.M. program won the National Criminal Justice Association, Midwest Region, Outstanding Criminal Justice Program Award in 2010.
