Course Summary

This is an advanced course focusing on the technical and tactical aspects of conducting a successful "Sting" operation targeting Survivor recovery, the arrest and prosecution of traffickers, and arrest of sex buyers. Students will learn how to target survivors, traffickers, and buyers for a mission specific



operation. Undercover techniques and education will be taught for both male and female officers. Students will learn how to conduct a successful operation through surveillance tactics and arrest team strategies. A "How To Build an Ad" will be presented to use for a buyer sting. Interview techniques for both survivors and suspects will be thoroughly discussed. Class will incorporate survivor recognition and assistance options. This is a "How To" class by Police detectives with years of experience in conducting undercover operations. This class is focused for Vice, Narcotic, and Multi-Jurisdictional Teams.

Case studies will be provided, including operations conducted by the instructors.
