

Deputy Sheriff, Law Enforcement Services (Road Patrol) position, full-time – Montcalm County Sheriff's Office

The Montcalm County Sheriff's Office is accepting applications for a full-time Sheriff's Deputy to fill several law enforcement services positions. The positions are being created in response to a recently passed law enforcement millage. Prerequisites include a High School diploma or equivalent and eligibility to be MCOLES certified. An Associate's degree or higher is preferred. Applicants must possess a valid Michigan Driver's License; have no felony convictions; be not less than 21 years of age; and must be able to pass a pre-employment background investigation, psychological evaluation, and drug test screening.

Montcalm County serves 20 townships consisting of a combined 720 square miles. The duties include patrol, criminal investigation, traffic enforcement, quelling disturbances, and traffic crash investigations. In addition to a defined benefit pension with a cost of living, the wage range is competitive and other benefits include health and eye care insurance.
